Travel Grant Awards

CWEN has **travel grant awards** available for CWEN members who are either graduate students or junior faculty/researchers and are presenting a research paper at a scholarly conference. Please note that the CWEN travel grants only covers part of the cost of travel to the meetings, and successful applicants should still expect to incur additional travel costs.

The number and amount of travel grants given will depend on yearly funding levels.

The following criteria are used to determine who will receive travel grants:

- Grants will only be given to individuals who are current members of CWEN
- Grants will only be given to individuals who are presenting a paper or participating in a poster session at a Canadian study group meeting or the Canadian Economic Association Meetings.
- Priority will be given to individuals who have not won the award in the past.
- Priority is given to individuals affiliated with Canadian institutions.
- Priority is given to those who have no other source of funds to finance travel to the conference.
- A notice of paper/poster acceptance will be needed to distribute the grant.

To apply for funds, please complete the attached application and email a scanned copy of the attached application along with a current CV to CWEN.RFE.travel@gmail.com.

The application deadline is March 31 of each year.

Successful applicants will be notified mid April by email.
